

School Uniform

All children are encouraged to wear and take pride in their school uniform. Whilst the basic items can be bought from any retailer, sweatshirts, cardigans and PE t shirts embroidered with our school logo - as well as fleeces, shower-proof jackets, bookbags, rucksacks and caps - need to be ordered via the school office. Please ask at the office for an order form.

Winter Uniform :

- purple sweatshirt or cardigan with embroidered school logo
- plain white polo shirt
- grey skirt or pinafore dress for girls
- plain grey or black trousers for boys
- plain socks or tights
- dark coloured sensible shoes (no heels, slip-ons or trainers)



Summer Uniform :

- lilac dresses, checked or striped for girls
- plain white polo shirt
- grey or black shorts or trousers for boys
- white or grey socks
- dark coloured shoes, or sandals that give full protection to the toes.

Shower-proof jackets and warmer, zipped fleece tops, in school colours with embroidered school logo, are optional but are available to order via the school office.

PE Kit

PE kit should be kept in a labeled PE bag, and should be in school hanging on your child's coat peg at ALL times (drawstring type bags are best as they hang easily under the coats). PE kits are sent home for washing at the end of each half term.

- purple t-shirt with embroidered school logo
- black shorts and tracksuit / jogging bottoms for colder weather
- white socks
- black plimsolls and/or trainers

It is useful for your child to keep a spare set of underwear in their PE bag ... just in case!

All weather gear

We encourage children to go out to play whatever the weather! It is therefore *essential* that they have:

- a pair of wellies to leave at school
- a waterproof coat with a hood
- appropriate seasonal clothes - ie hat and gloves in winter, sun hat in summer.

For safety reasons and in line with County policy we do not allow jewellery to be worn in school.

****Please ensure ALL items of clothing and equipment, including PE kit, are clearly named****
