In Peregrine Class we have been creating Willow 'Sculptures' to represent our learning ...

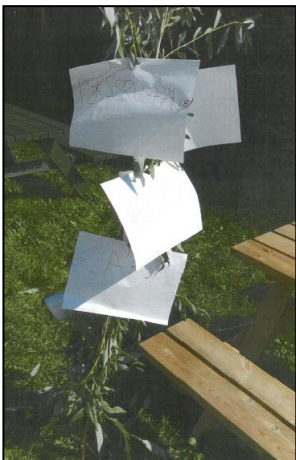
