Department for Education Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium:

ALL pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport. The funding has been provided to ensure impact against the following objective: To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools.

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

1. the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
2. the profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. increased participation in competitive sport

Dance Workshop	£135	All children involved in high-quality dance led by a specialist – whole school involvement.
Lunch time football/basketball/netball club (South Coast Sports Coaching)	£1646	Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils. Greater opportunities for pupils to learn key skills and sporting spirit values through club participation.
Football tournament entries at local school	£60	
Curriculum specialist teaching (South Coast Sports Coaching)	£8515	All classes engaged in weekly PE & sport activity sessions. Opportunities for pupils to try new games, develop skills and work collaboratively with a range of sports teachers and coaches. Ideas, support materials and sessions shared and evaluated to improve staff delivery, understanding and confidence.
Additional swimming lessons (DPD Coaching Services)	£920	Regular swimming sessions for Year 3, 4, 5 and 6. Children are taught to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke] and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
Minibus costs	£300	Increased pupil participation and engagement of physical exercise, particularly for those children who do not respond positively to competitive team games.
Forest School Training and supply costs	£2049	Forest School allows all learners to develop confidence and self-esteem. Increased pupil participation and engagement of physical exercise, particularly for those children who do not respond positively to competitive team games.

Sports Day resources and field markings	£123	Promoting sports and celebrating achievements. Parental involvement with sports. Promoting a healthy lifestyle.
Maths of the Day subscription	£445	Raise attainment and attitudes towards maths through active lesson plans. Increases levels of physical activity and promotes a healthy lifestyle.
