Our School Improvement plan in 2018/2019 will be working on developing progression documents with our developing curriculum opportunities. Teaching in the Moment creates the teaching times when children can be moved on individually within the learning that stems from their own interests.

As two Church Schools, it is important to us to understand the religious and spiritual needs of all children and families across our Federation. Within a Christian context, we enable all children and their families to explore their own faiths. We develop the skills of mindfulness and provide quiet and calm times for reflection. It is absolutely vital for children to be able to have a voice and freedom in their choices of faith.

Linked to our annual year 6 trip to the Houses of Parliament, all year groups from 2-6 will have weekly discussions with the headteacher to develop their leadership skills and share their views on improvements in the school, particularly linked to their own learning journeys and climate change actions. We will work on developing respectful conversations initiated by their own motivations and interests.

Based on the book 'Doughnut Economics' by Kate Raworth, which discusses the requirement for all institutions, countries and global decisions to be based on a circular economy where all resources are re-used and these planetary boundaries alter policy making.
