



Once upon a time - Autumn 1 Half Term Topic.

<p>Dear Year 1 and 2 Parents, Here is our topic web and enquiry question for this half term. Please read this to see what your child will be learning this half term</p>	 Enquiry Question - What if the pigs chose different materials for their houses?	
<p>As AUTHORS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write for a variety of purposes <p>Year 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin to write letters in the cursive way Practise saying sentences before writing them Learn how to spell some year 1 tricky words <p>Year 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin to join some letters Make improvements to our sentences verbally before writing them Learn different words types – adjectives, nouns, verbs. Learn how to spell some year 2 tricky words 	<p>As MATHEMATICIANS we will learn</p> <p>Year 1 NUMBER- NUMBER AND PLACE VALUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens <p style="text-align: center;">ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> read, write and understand the addition (+), subtraction (–) and equals (=) signs add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero <p>Year 2 NUMBER- NUMBER AND PLACE VALUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 forward and backwards recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones - 13 has 1 ten and 3 ones) compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100 <p style="text-align: center;">ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 i.e. $13 + 7 = 20$ add and subtract numbers using objects or by drawing pictures 	<p>As READERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learn lots of new phonics sounds – please look out for our online parent workshop on Phonics and how you can support at home (TBC) READ AT LEAST THREE TIMES A WEEK AT HOME Read The Three Little Pigs Role-play parts of the story Read different traditional tales and compare them Create a ‘New Words’ display board – we are aiming to learn 100 new words by half term! If you come across words your child does not know when reading at home please write them down and remind the children to them add to our display.
<p>As SCIENTISTS we will learn about materials</p> <p>Year 1 will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ask simple questions and identify and classify materials distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock <p>Year 2 will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ask simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. 	<p>As GEOGRAPHERS we will</p> <p>Year 1 - Identify the 4 countries making the United Kingdom and name their capital cities</p> <p>Year 2 - Point out on a globe or an atlas, the equator, the north and south poles, the world’s 7 continents and 5 oceans</p> <p>As DESIGNERS we will</p> <p>Year 1 – Build structures and explore mechanisms (e.g. levers, sliders, wheels and axles)</p> <p>Year 2 - Explore how structures can be made stronger, stiffer or more stable Use mechanisms, such as levers, sliders, wheels and axles, in their products</p> <p>As ARTISTS we will</p> <p>Year 1 – Name the primary colours and mix them to create secondary colours and describe what they think and feel about their own work and another artist’s work</p> <p>Year 2- Make tints by adding white and tones by adding black and create a piece of work in response to another artist’s work and then suggest how to make it even better</p>
