Reverend Vivien writes:

Once again in our assembly we remembered Sidney, a boy who attended Graffham School a hundred and twenty years ago, like the children there today, and went to fight in World War I. Having been wounded, Sidney was brought home where he died of his wounds and was laid to rest in St Giles Churchyard Extension. He was 19 when he died. We thought how brave he must have been, how sad his family would have been that he had died, and how important it is for the world to learn to live in peace.

After the assembly, I took the wreath I brought to school to the churchyard to lay on Sidney's grave. I noticed it could do with some tidying up. If anyone in Graffham would like to do this for Sidney, please let me know.

It's our 'Third Sunday' Service when we are especially pleased to welcome families and this time is inspired by Celtic worship.

Please also note that the Foodbank distribution point for the village has now been moved to the church as it can no longer be kept at the shop.
