



Once Upon a Time - Autumn 1 Half Term Topic.

<p>As AUTHORS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • name the letters of the alphabet • practise saying sentences before writing them • begin to leave spaces between words • explore capital letters and full stops • learn how to spell some year 1 tricky words 	<p>As MATHEMATICIANS we will learn to:</p> <p>NUMBER- NUMBER AND PLACE VALUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • count and sort objects of different amounts • begin to recognise numbers as words • form numbers 0-9 correctly <p>ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • count on from any number • count backwards within 10 	<p>As READERS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • learn lots of new phonics sounds • READ AT LEAST THREE TIMES A WEEK AT HOME • read The Three Little Pigs • role-play parts of the story • read different traditional tales and compare them
<p>As SCIENTISTS we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ask simple questions and identify and classify materials • distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made • identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock 	<p>As HISTORIANS we will ... explore and answer questions about toys in the past and compare them to our toys today.</p> <p>As GEOGRAPHERS we will ... use different maps in small world. Begin to understand directions- up, down, left, right.</p> <p>As ARTISTS we will... explore mark making and start to building mark making vocabulary. Use large brushes and small brushes. Print with a range of hard and soft materials.</p>
