As SCIENTISTS we will....

- Learn what the solar system is.
- Find out about major components of our solar system.
- Learn to name and order the 8 planets.
- Investigate what makes our planet so special.

As DESIGNERS we will......

- Create a mini planetarium so that we can display our learning.
- Choose appropriate techniques for attaching and suspending planets/stellar objects.
- Investigate and apply ideas around moving parts.

AS HISTORIANS we will ...

- Learn about Neil Armstrong and the moon landings.
- Learn about Mars rovers and scientific craft landings, focussing on Curiosity.
