



Heroes and Villains Summer 1 Half Term Topic

<p>Dear Year 1 Parents,</p> <p>Here is our topic web and enquiry question for this half term. Please read this to see what your child will be learning this half term.</p>	 <p>Year 1</p> <p>Enquiry Question – Do we need villains in stories?</p>	
<p>As AUTHORS we will....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write detailed character descriptions. • Use characters we describe in short narratives we write individually and as a group. • Add the suffix –ing to words. • Write plurals with –es and –s. 	<p>As MATHEMATICIANS we will.....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn to add equal groups as we begin to understand multiplication. • Begin looking at fractions, finding halves and quarters of shapes. • Count in 2's, 5's and 10's to 20 and 100. • Look at arrays around us and make our own arrays. Making doubles to 20. 	<p>As READERS we will....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please continue to READ AT LEAST THREE TIMES A WEEK AT HOME. • Read key text: Inside the Villains and traditional fairy tales • Learn alternative sounds e.g. ai, ae, ay, a-e ready for phonic screening check. • Read alien words (not real words).
<p>As SCIENTISTS we will....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning the names of the different parts of a plant. • Look at the difference between wild plants and garden plants and name them. • Learn about deciduous and evergreen trees and look at these in our local area. 	<p>As ARTISTS we will.....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at images of heroes and villains from popular fairy tales. • Make pop up villainous characters from paper and card, inspired by the artwork of Clotilde Perrin. • Look at and draw big shapes using felt pens and oil pastels to create texture and detail. 	
	<p>AS HISTORIANS we will ...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about and celebrate VE Day. Explain about how some people from the past have made our lives better today.
