MY CHILD AT SCHOOL (MCAS)

All parents from Reception to Y5 have been sent information about MCAS, currently our families at Graffham & Duncton use ParentPay to order hot lunches. From September when we will be cooking all our own meals, this ordering service will move to a new platform called 'My Child at School' (MCAS). This is a secure online portal that gives parents and carers real-time access to important information about their child's school life. MCAS can be accessed through the mobile app or via a web browser, helping you stay informed and engaged with your child's education.

Over time, MCAS will provides access to a wide range of pupil data and services, including: attendance records, clubs, trips, home/school communication (replacing our current emails and texts) **The clubs and trips section in MCAS and the emails/texts will not be available initially as our priority is to enable all families to order hot lunches through the MCAS system.**
